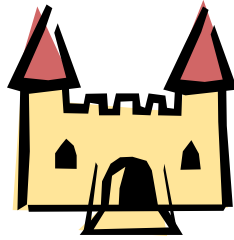


## Health and Safety

1. All children are required to have health forms. (Forms 3940 and 680 are provided by your child's pediatrician.) **NO CHILD WILL BE PERMITTED TO ATTEND SCHOOL WITHOUT THESE HEALTH FORMS.**
2. A child should be kept at home if he/she is ill during the night or has had a poor night's sleep. This may be first sign of impending illness
3. If your child is starting to snuffle, even if he/she has no temperature, please keep the child at home. **IT IS TO EVERYONE'S BENEFIT, INCLUDING YOUR CHILD'S, THAT CHILDREN WITH THE BEGINNING OF A COLD STAY AT HOME.** Parents will be asked to pick up their child if he/she appears ill or contagious. If your child habitually comes to school sick, you will have to confer with the director to discuss the matter.
4. In case of contagious disease, please notify the school at once. All parents will be notified by the school when a child in the group has a contagious disease so that you may check with your physician. If your child should catch a contagious disease, we must have a note from the child's physician stating that the child is in good health before the child will be readmitted.
5. Please call the school office when your child is absent for two consecutive days so that we may better plan for his/her return to school.

### MEDICINE

No medication will be administered by members of our staff unless accompanied by an authorized medical form and the medication is in the original bottle that is prescribed by a medical doctor.

### SAFETY

Fire drills are held periodically throughout the school year. It is each teacher's responsibility to teach her students the proper procedure for executing the school fire drill.
